Cheam was founded in 1645 and is one of the oldest prep schools in the world. Cheam is an IAPS boarding and day school with some 375 pupils, boys, and girls. Cheam prides itself on its excellent all-round record academically, musically, artistically and on the sports field. The facilities are outstanding. On completing their life at Cheam, children move on to the top Public Schools in England, including Eton, Wellington, Marlborough, Radley, Harrow, Winchester, Bradfield and St. Mary's Calne. The school is non-selective yet achieves consistently high standards academically.

JOB DESCRIPTION

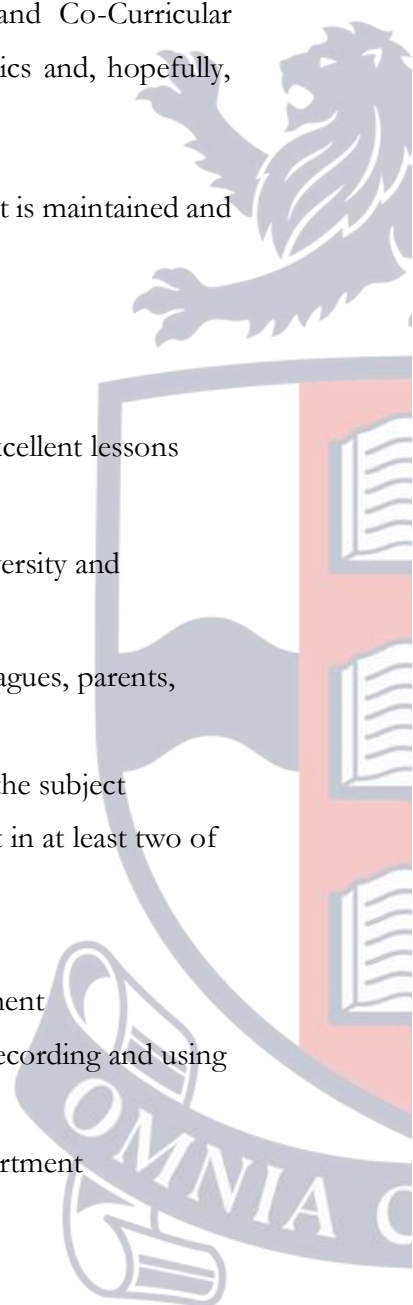


We are looking for someone with an excellent understanding of best practice in the teaching of PE across more than one key stage. The successful candidate will have excellent leadership, organisation, prioritisation, ICT and communication skills. As well as teaching PE across the key stages, they will be expected to contribute meaningfully to the Games and Co-Curricular programmes. We expect candidates to be secure in the teaching of Gymnastics and, hopefully, Dance in order to further our provision.

They will be responsible to the Director of Sport for ensuring the PE equipment is maintained and will oversee the ordering of any new equipment as and when necessary.

The Head of PE will:

- teach PE throughout the school, planning, developing and delivering excellent lessons
- monitor and assess the children's progress
- help develop the curriculum to allow it to move forward in terms of diversity and provision
- ensure good levels of communication with the whole community (colleagues, parents, pupils, Grounds staff)
- be responsible to the Director of Sport for the standard of teaching of the subject
- have a desire to drive our extra curriculum sport and be very competent in at least two of our major sports (Hockey, Football, Netball, Rugby & Cricket)
- be an active participant in our sports tour programme
- be responsible for the close scrutiny of performance within the department
- monitor, assess and appraise the quality of learning within the classes, recording and using data to aid future development
- take ownership of ensuring the development of the pupils and the department
- manage and produce a budget annually
- oversee the organisation of minor sports within the school



JOB DESCRIPTION



- prepare appropriate wall displays
- attend appropriate fixtures and sporting events as required by the school
- innovate and develop ways in which to champion PE within the whole school
- oversee and implement an effective and creative Scheme of Work for the subject
- organise Departmental Meetings when required and supply programmes of study and other such documents
- attend Heads of Department meetings as required
- attend relevant courses and suggest appropriate ones for the departmental members
- become involved in promoting the subject throughout the school in the organisation of suitable trips and excursions, and through other initiatives
- report to parents through the school's usual procedures
- ensure the safeguarding and personal care of all children in the school will assist in completing an annual review of the school's sport provision

Other Responsibilities

A willingness to contribute to the life of the school beyond the usual school day is considered essential. There is an appropriate level of duties, in line with other staff including daytime and evening duties.

Teaching at Cheam

It is expected that candidates for all teaching posts will support the strong collective dynamic and inspirational ethos of the educational philosophy of the school and support the community aims of our school life. We are looking for a candidate who has confidence, integrity, humility, fun and humour and is happy to give their time, expertise, skill and intellect to children and colleagues.

Salary and Hours

Salary will be competitive, according to experience and qualifications.

This is a full time role. Full time staff work six days a week and are entitled to a half day off during the week. This usually begins at 11.30am and goes on through to the next morning.

School Holidays | Days Off

School holidays are usually 3 weeks at Christmas, 3 weeks at Easter, 8 weeks in the summer, 1 week for February, May and October half terms. There are regular staff meetings and INSET days just before the start of each term and all staff are expected to attend these.
