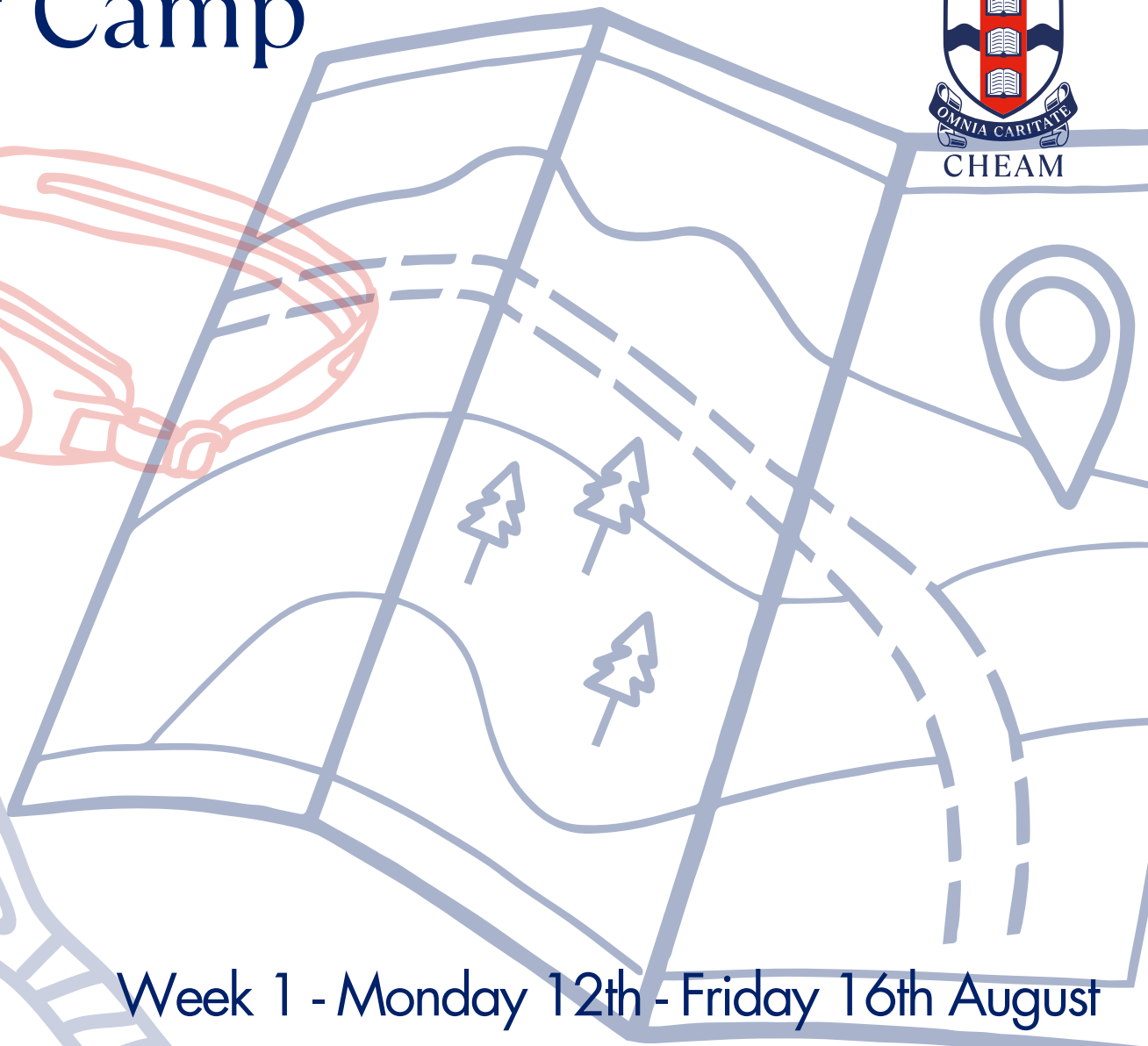
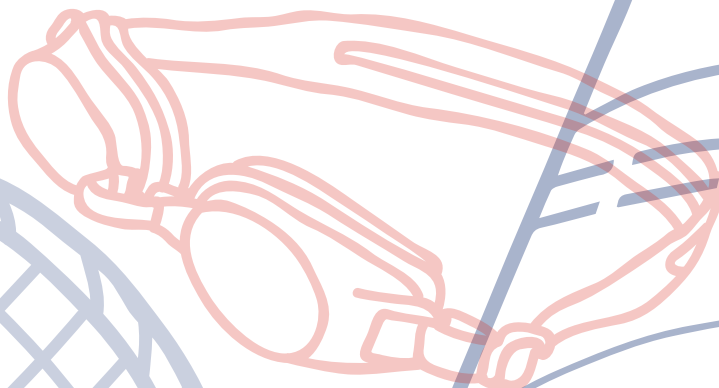
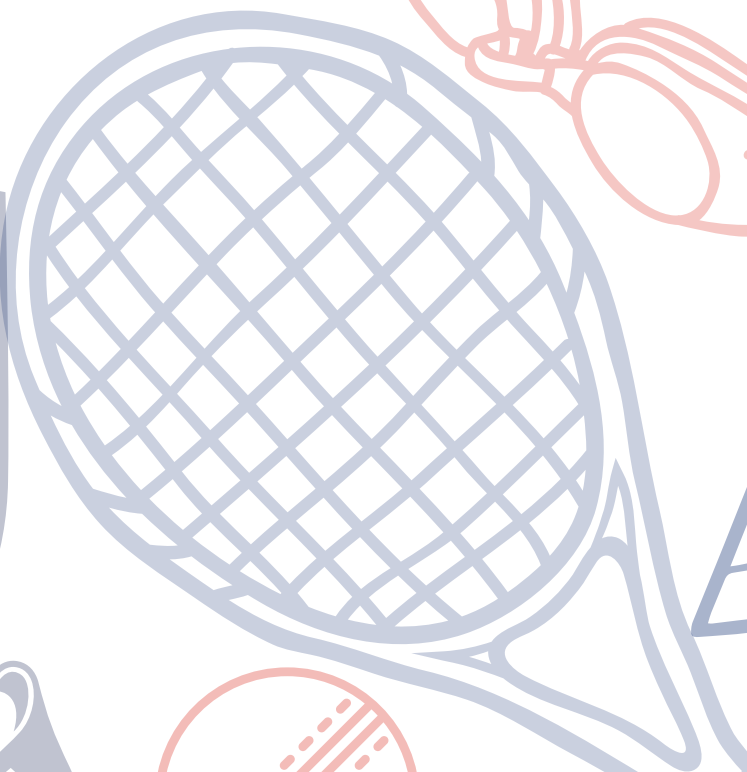


# Cheam Summer Camp

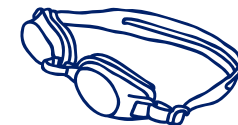
### Activities

## Arrival & Pick up



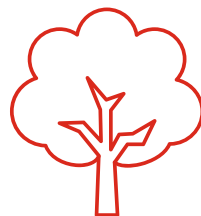

### Food & Drink

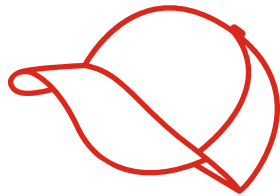
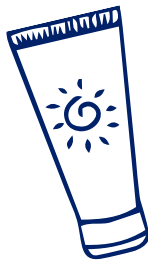
Drinks and biscuits are provided throughout the day; however, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch and plenty to drink each day.

Snacks to keep your child going during the day are also useful, as they will be highly active! No nuts please.



## First Aid & Medical Matters

- Basic first aid is provided.
- Any medical requirements must be included on the application form.
- If your child has either an Epi-pen or an inhaler, please ensure you leave it with us along with clear instructions on dosage and triggers.
- Staff will apply basic first aid (plasters, cream, sprays, etc) unless we are specifically asked not to.
- We will have a limited amount of sun cream so please provide this if appropriate weather.
- A sun hat or cap is also extremely useful if the sun decides to show itself!



## Clothing



- Dress for the weather.
- Jeans are not a good idea; tracksuits bottoms are ideal.
- Shorts in warm weather are perfect.
- Trainers should be worn (not flip-flops).
- Socks are a good idea to prevent blisters!
- Your child will be running around and might get dirty, so comfortable and non-precious clothing is essential.
- Trainers are the most sensible footwear, and your child may want to bring a pair of boots for 'Hide in the Woods,' which happens on Tuesday and Thursday.
- 'Hide in the Woods' clothing - clothing which helps protect the children from brambles and nettles will be very useful.
- Mobile phones and other devices are not required for this camp. Cheam Summer Camp accepts no responsibility for loss or damage; we can store them away if they are handed in.

# Location

Cheam School is situated in Headley on the A339. We will base ourselves on the school Loggia which is on the southern side of the main building, overlooking the formal garden.

Please park/drop off by going through the North Entrance, turning right and parking in the large gravel car park. A short walk through the shrubs will bring you to the front of school. There will be staff to guide you on your arrival.

In case of emergency or dropping off/picking up outside the normal times, please use the North Entrance, turning left and parking in front of the main school. There is a gap in the hedge to the left of the school which will lead you to the Loggia where you will find a member of staff.

Please drive carefully through the school grounds, keeping your speed down.
